I'm joining the annual **100% Solution - Bike Ride for Life**, which is underway for the 15th year. I will be participating for the twelfth time. Some of you have supported me for the past 7 years, and hopefully will be able to continue doing so.

In the past 14 years the riders have raised well over 900.000.00. All the money raised has gone directly to help people in need. With your help we will continue to make a difference.

Tuesday's Angels is an organization that I have actively supported for some time. The primary focus of the group is to provide intervention to men women and children with **AIDS** facing financial crisis. The organization is a **100%** volunteer group whose members personally fund all administrative costs. Thus, all monies raised are funneled to persons with **AIDS**. **Tuesday's Angels** is an IRS designated nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization.

This year's 208 mile roundtrip ride along A1A is to Fort Pierce and back on April 16 and 17 . Each rider absorbs any cost incurred for training and the ride (e.g., equipment, housing, food and drink). The bikers start out at 6:00 am Friday morning and return to Fort Lauderdale by sundown Sunday. To accomplish the excursion, riders will peddle for up to 30 hours. To achieve proper conditioning, some participants will accumulate thousands of miles and countless hours on their bike. I am joining the riders in their momentous endeavor by making a commitment to help achieve the financial goal.
